★ INSTRUCTIONS ★



Thank you for downloading Logan's Winter Adventure Bingo!

This game is designed to make learning, communication, and fun come together! ♥

★ HOW TO PLAY ★

- 1 Print your bingo cards and calling cards. Each player gets a bingo card. 
- 2 Cut out the calling cards. Place them face down in a pile. 
- 3 Take a calling card from the pile. Show it to the players and say the word. 
- 4 Players look for the matching picture on their bingo card. If they have it, they can cover it. 
- 5 The first player to get 5 in a row (across, down, or diagonally) yells **BINGO!** Check their card to make sure all the pictures match. 
- 6 Keep playing for blackout (covering all the pictures) for an extra challenge!

★ WAYS TO ADAPT THE GAME ★



EARLY LEARNERS

Use fewer calling cards. Focus on matching and naming the pictures.



AAC USERS

Find the word on their AAC device and say it before covering it.



GROUP PLAY

Play in small groups or pairs so everyone gets a turn.



ADVANCED PLAYERS

Play for blackout or use a timer for a fun race to BINGO!



★ TIPS FOR LONG-LASTING USE ★



1. CUT

Cut out all calling cards.



2. PRINT

Print on cardstock for extra durability.



3. LAMINATE

Laminate the cards for years of use.



4. STORE

Store in a zipper bag or small storage box.



5. MARKERS

Use bingo chips, buttons, coins, or pom-poms.

TIPS FOR LONG-LASTING USE



1. PRINT

Print on cardstock for durability.



2. LAMINATE

Laminate the cards to protect them from spills, wear, and tear.



3. CUT

Cut along the dotted lines for clean edges. Round the corners for safety.



4. STORE

Keep the cards in a zipper bag or small box so they stay organized and protected.



5. CLEAN

Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Let dry before storing.

HOW TO PLAY

- 1 Print your bingo cards and calling cards.
- 2 Cut out the calling cards. Place them face down in a pile.
- 3 Take a card, show it, and say the word.
- 4 Players find the matching picture on their card and cover it.
- 5 Get 5 in a row (across, down, or diagonally) and yell **BINGO**!
